New Year, New Resolutions: Could you help steward Church hires?

If you are looking for a way to help the church on an occasional basis, we need more members to help steward non-church events. Our current list of volunteers is too small. If you volunteer, you will then be included in the round-robin to consider signing up for an event which suits you on the inevitable rota. Helping just once or twice a year is ok.

To volunteer, you need to be physically agile enough to open fire exits and provide help in an emergency.

Stewarding allows us to hire the church for £16 an hour, so this can be one of the most cost-effective ways of helping the church, especially if it is an event you would have attended anyway. Typical events are Leven Voices choir, Kinross Floral Art Club, Loch Leven Equine Vets Practice, Kinross-shire Historical Society and various concerts.
