### Pray for Community, Nation and World

During May we mark Christian Aid Week, and the General Assembly meets seeking guidance for the future of the Church of Scotland. From Ascension (30<sup>th</sup> May) to Pentecost (9<sup>th</sup> June) we are called to join in a worldwide movement praying the Lord's Prayer, with the intention of seeing people in our community come to faith in Christ.

**Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May** – *Proverbs 10:22-32*. Midweek Service at the Church Centre at 10.45am. Craft Group at 1.30pm.
