Prayer Diary – September 2019

Season of Prayer – September-December 2019

The General Assembly of 2019 called the whole Church to a season of prayer this autumn, as we prepare for radical change in the church, in the face of significant challenges in our day. There will be a Concert of Prayer in the church from 7am-7pm on Saturday 7th September when you can drop in for a short act of worship on the hour every hour and some time for personal prayer. There will also be a Time for Prayer each Wednesday in the church at midday. Together let us seek the Lord's guiding and blessing as we humble ourselves before Him in prayer.

Sunday 1st September – *Deut. 5:1-3 – A Covenant with Us.* Communion Service at 10.30am (Creche, Junior Church, Jampact with Youth Communion). Crossfire at 7pm. Pray that there may be a deep sense of the Lord's presence at His Table today. [Station Rd, Kirklands Ct, Swansacre, Lomond Mews, Queen's Cres, Douglas Cres, Primary School]

Monday 2nd – *Deut. 5:4-5 – Face to face with God.* Silent meditation at 8am. Visitors' Groups at 10am. Pray that this season of prayer will be a time for all of us to grow closer to God. [High St (Bank of Scotland to Church Centre), Police Houses, St. Ronan's Dr, Chambers Ct, Talla Pk]
