The Moderator, Rt. Revd. Rosie Frew, said: 'Our hope and prayer is for mutual respect and a commitment to justice, peace and reconciliation in our land and worldwide.'

NEW: Moderator Chooses Christian Aid: Rt. Revd. Rosie Frew has named Christian Aid as the chosen charity for her year as Moderator. She 'invites us all to reflect on how we show extravagant love to our global neighbours, and to join her in donating to the works of Christian Aid.'
