Stamp Appeal – last chance to hand in used stamps: The Church of Scotland Stamp Appeal – running for 30 years – is coming to an end in February. So, this is your last chance, especially with Christmas post, to cut out used stamps (please leave a minimum of 1/4inch (5mm) around stamps) and leave them in the collection tubs in the church vestibule. Stamp collections are particularly welcome.

By 2024, the Appeal had raised over £96,000 for annual projects connected to World Mission. It is currently supporting the Al-Ahili Hospital, the only Christian hospital in Gaza, which has continued to operate through the bombings since 2023, including fatal hits on the hospital.

The Appeal has always depended on the hard work of the amazing Keith Scott, an elder in Wishaw, who throughout 30 years has received the stamps, sorted them, and ensured a best price, especially for unusual stamps and stamp collections.

In our congregation our thanks are due to Kathleen S. and her predecessors for collecting the stamps, sorting them and passing them on to Keith Scott.

NEW: Bondi Beach attack: The Moderator, Rt Rev Rosie Frew, has issued a statement expressing the Church of Scotland's sympathy for those affected by the Bondi Beach attack, the wider Jewish community and the people of Australia.

Book of Confessions: A new book of confessions was published by the Church of Scotland last week. This follows a detailed seven-year review of the confessional position of the Church led by the Theological Forum. The new book has been approved by Presbyteries and the General Assembly and 'provides a more holistic account of the Church's faith.'
