NEW: UN Anniversary: Rt Rev Rosie Frew, the Moderator, represented the Church of Scotland last week at a Service of Thanksgiving in Methodist Central Hall, London to mark the 80th. anniversary of the first meeting of the General Assembly of the United Nations in the same building.

Rosie Frew said: ' I pray that the UN can indeed be one place where the world's nations can gather together, discuss common problems and find shared solutions.'

Training of Ministers: The Church's People and Training Team is recommending that Trinity College (University of Glasgow) becomes the Lead Academic Partner of the Church in the training of Ministers and Deacons. This is part of major changes to training starting in 2027 and has to be approved by the General Assembly.
