NEW: Preaching in Jerusalem: The Moderator, Rosie Frew, was intending to visit the Holy Land as part of a pilgrimage group at the end of March to show solidarity with the Christian community of Palestine and Israel. The visit was cancelled following the US and Israel attacks on Iran. Rosie Frew was planned to preach in person at the St Andrew's Scots Memorial Church in Jerusalem on Easter Sunday but instead she preached via an online link.
