Sunday 8 June: On this Day of Pentecost, pray that today would be a day for each of us to be open to encounter the living God in a new way and for Christ to have His way in us and among us and through us by the work of the Holy Spirit.

Monday 9 June: Pray today for those who gather in the church on Monday afternoons and evenings for fellowship over table games, that those from beyond the congregation who feel comfortable joining in may find their way into the life of the church.

Tuesday 10 June: Pray today for those who come along to Stepping Stones in the church on Tuesday mornings, that those from outwith the congregation may know themselves to be welcomed and supported and may come to know the love of Jesus for themselves.

Thursday 12 June: Pray for those in the congregation who belong to one of the house-groups meeting regularly with others for Bible study, fellowship and prayer, that each person would find support and encouragement and would find their faith deepened.

Friday 13 June: Pray for people in the wider community who are searching for meaning in life that they may see the Holy Spirit at work among God's people and find fulfilment for their spiritual longings. Pray that our church may be a place of encounter with God for all people.

Saturday 14 June: God of heaven and earth, before the foundation of the universe and the beginning of time you are the triune God, the Author of creation, the eternal Word of salvation, the life-giving Spirit of wisdom. Guide us into all truth by your Spirit that we may proclaim all that Christ revealed and rejoice in the glory He shared with us. Glory and praise to you, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever.
